Aurukun Facilities

The Aurukun Bauxite Project will require the establishment of new facilities in Aurukun to support the construction and operation of the project. These new facilities will help ensure that fuel and food can reach the mine all year round (including during the wet season) throughout operations.

The new facilities will support the supply of important items (such as fuel) to the mine as well as the transportation of workers. Items such as fuel and equipment will be delivered by barge to Aurukun. We expect that there will be space on the existing (or a slightly larger) weekly barge service. This would not impact existing community access to barging services.

POTENTIAL NEW FACILITIES

We will need to discuss any new or changed facilities further with the community and Aurukun Shire Council however they could include:

- Improvements to the Aurukun Barge Landing to increase the speed of unloading
- A separate “laydown” area to ensure that delivered goods are stored away from the Aurukun waterfront area
- A fuel storage facility to store fuel delivered by barge until it can be transported to the mine

The location of these facilities would be subject to the Aurukun Town Planning Scheme and would need to consider potential impacts on community.



USE OF EXISTING FACILITIES

Based on our current project planning, the project will require use of the following existing facilities in Aurukun:

Aurukun Road:

- Two fuel trucks per day will travel from Aurukun to the site plus other deliveries
- A bus will transport workers from Aurukun to the mine

Airport

- An additional flight per day may be needed to transport non-local workers

Office

- A project office would be maintained in Aurukun
